
A FELLOWSHIP CENTER & REMODELED SANCTUARY TO SUPPORT THE NANAKULI VALLEY & THE WEST SIDE.

# HOW CAN I HELP?



## PRAYER SUPPORT

Pray! It is imperative that we cover this whole campaign in prayer. We will be encouraging everyone to participate through times of prayer and fasting over a 40-day period. Also, there will be information about how you can join an intense 24-hour prayer vigil.



## FINANCIALLY

We ask people to prayerfully discern giving outside their normal tithes and offering in both of these ways:

- A one-time "first fruits:" This is giving that is available immediately.
- Pledges: These are monthly pledges to provide support for a three-year period.

## SPREAD THE WORD

Get your friends, family, and the community excited about what God is doing at NPC! Share with them this vision of our UNITED IN ALOHA campaign. God may lay it on their hearts to be a part of this vision as well!



**When does the campaign begin and what is its purpose?** The campaign begins on Sunday, September 7th, with 40 days of prayer and fasting and will conclude with a celebration Sunday at church on November 23rd, where totals will be announced. The purpose of this campaign is to raise funds to construct our new community center and remodel our existing sanctuary to increase our community reach.

**How much will the improvements cost?** We will be going through a bid process. The preliminary range is \$750,000 to \$1,000,000.

**How will the funds be raised?** Funds will be raised in a variety of ways. There will be church family aspect of United in Aloha where each of us will be invited to go on a prayer journey and prayerfully consider how we might financially participate; the congregation will pledge on November 2nd. This is a step of faith and we all get a front row seat to watching the Lord bless.

**If I decide to give, how long would I be making this pledge?** The duration of the giving period will be three years, however, donations can also be a one-time gift.

**What if my financial situation changes after I make my commitment?** While we hope that won't happen for you, we understand that the future is unknown. If your situation changes, you and your family would determine the most appropriate response. As this is a commitment between you Lord, we trust you will prayerfully work through it with the Lord.

**Will I get a tax receipt for my donations?** Yes, all funds donated to the United in Aloha fund will receive the same tax receipting as any other giving to NPC.

**How can I help with or fully participate in this?** We ask that you join us in prayer, as God is the one who will ultimately provide for His church. Prayer is not the only thing that we will do, but it must be the first thing. Join us in our “40 days of Prayer and Fasting” that begins Monday, September 8th, but also join us for the upcoming “24-hour Prayer Vigil” on October 24th & 25th. More information on the Prayer Vigil will be coming soon!

**Can my employer match my gift if they have a matching program?** The business would receive a donation receipt for tax purposes the same as an individual donor. You may need to look at the regulations for your employer’s matching funds. We would be happy to help however we can.

**Is this commitment/pledge in addition to my normal giving?** Yes. We’re asking that whatever you pledge for the 3-year-period would be over and above your normal giving. We use the General Operating Fund, where your normal tithes and offerings are placed, for the day-to-day operations of the church. The funds pledged for United in Aloha will be placed in a separate fund to be used solely for the purposes listed above.

**Where can I get further information about United in Aloha?** Pastor Allen and his team will be visiting several small gatherings between September 21st through October 16th, so that you can hear more and ask questions. We will be sharing location and times for these gatherings so more info to follow.
